Family Conversations

- 1 What kind of clothing do people wear to a wedding?
- 2 What might a bride and groom think if someone didn't dress up for their special event?
- 3 Who do you invite to your home as guests? Who invites your family to be guests in their home? What makes someone a good host? A good guest?
- 4 Invite an adult family member to find a few pictures from their wedding. Talk about what happened on that day. Are the people in the picture happy? Discuss why or why not.



Eye Spark

This week, look for people dressed in clothing appropriate for attending a wedding or other fancy event. When you spot an example, say to yourself or a family member, "I am invited to God's feast."



Ear Spark

Listen for love songs or Christian songs on the radio. When you hear one, think about the joy, laughter, music, and feasting we will share at the banquet God has prepared for us.
