A new role that combines many former roles is our Worship Guide. These people will help guide us in worship. They care for, set boundaries, uphold, and walk people through the unique worship experience. They are a combination of Greeter, Usher and Sexton all rolled into one.

- Arrive early to set up signs and facilitate the worship space
- Greet those who are coming and assist them in meeting the health team
- Usher them to find seats and participate in worship.
- After the service is over, change out chairs as needed, clean up, take care of the gifts and tithes that have been offered and care for the space.
