WEEKLY MILESTONES

Take a moment to tell or think about a recent mountain high and/or valley low in your life.

CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your home, small group, or use for personal reflections:

- Have you personally used *Taking Faith Home* this past year? If so, how?
- In what ways have you encouraged others in the congregation and community to use *Taking Faith Home*?

DEVOTIONS

Read: Deuteronomy 6:4-9.

We are not born with faith embedded within our DNA structure. Faith has to be learned in life from others. Teaching the faith and passing on the faith to the next generation does not happen through the work of congregations alone. One needs to speak and hear faith at home as well. In Deuteronomy we see the power of cross-generational conversation and rituals and traditions to help children and adults be nourished in God's word for a life of faith. People need to be immersed into a faith-filled environment in the home to become fluent in a faith language. Fluency in a language cannot happen with only a one or two hour a week exposure within a congregational faith community. There has to be greater and more consistent immersion into a faith-filled nurturing environment to learn.

Discuss: Who has helped you grow in the Christian faith? How can you support others in living God's word?

Pray: **Loving God, thank you for your word of life that gives us hope and joy and is a source of encouragement to us as we grow in grace through Christ our Lord. Amen.**

SERVICE

Jesus calls us to serve our neighbor in love. Have you considered sending a copy of *Taking Faith Home* by mail or electronically to a friend, neighbor, or nearby congregation to make them aware of this valuable faith formation resource?

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Taking Faith Home bulletin inserts are based on the Revised Common Lectionary. There is an insert for each Sunday, special days, and some holidays. Each insert includes the Four Key Faith Practices of caring conversations, devotions, service, and rituals and traditions. They also include the weekly theme, daily Bible readings, a scripture verse, a weekly prayer, a mealtime prayer, a blessing to give, a hymn, and a time to talk about weekly mountain highs and valley lows. It can be helpful to distribute the *Taking Faith Home* User Guide to each of your congregational members in November to assist them on how to best utilize this faith formation resource during the coming year.
